

Joining the Networks: Research Governance & Research Strategy

The primary goal of AAMRI's MRI networks is to connect staff with similar interests and roles at our member institutes.

Through the networks, MRI staff can connect to discuss common challenges & issues, which are often specific to MRIs. By sharing ideas, MRIs can work together on solutions to common problems.

How it works:

- * Communication across the networks is facilitated through membership of a private google group.
- * Members post to the group and receive posts via email.
- * Staff from AAMRI member institutes can be members of more than one network.
- * Membership is restricted to staff at AAMRI member institutes.
- * Annual networking event.
